The n-Lorem Nano-rare Patient Colloquium (NRPC) will be held once again on October 7-8, 2026, at the Boston Marriott Cambridge. Our 2025 colloquium inspired many with shared optimism and enthusiasm for the future of the equitable and personalized treatment of nano-rare diseases. This community event unites n-Lorem patients and their families, supporters, physicians, industry leaders, and others under a single roof to highlight the foundation's most recent advancements in patient treatment, share firsthand patient experiences and perspectives, spark new hope for those who have none through powerful case studies of patients who have benefitted from treatment, and address the crucial challenges facing the nano-rare disease community today. The 2025 colloquium was the largest to date, attracting global interest with attendees from over 30 countries. More than 275 participated in person and over 600 joined virtually via the live stream, bringing the total audience to nearly 900 individuals.

Patients remain at the heart of the colloquium, and their participation continues to grow each year. In 2025, we saw an 82% increase in attendance from patients and their families, made possible through sponsor support that helped offset travel costs. Looking ahead to 2026, we aim to build on this momentum.
